# 3.1 S.T.O.P. Work Authority

All employees and contractors are empowered and required to incorporate S.T.O.P Work Authority into their job functions and team processes.

- S See unsafe or noncompliant behavior or process
- T Tell someone immediately
- O Order any unsafe behavior to cease
- P Postpone operations until the behavior or process is compliant and safe to proceed

## 3.2 Legal/Regulatory Compliance

Chesapeake safe operations includes understanding and complying with all federal, state and local laws and regulations associated with our operations. Business processes must be structured to meet this minimum expectation.

## 3.3 Incident Identification and Reporting

Employees and contractors shall promptly report any perceived risk, including any incident or near miss, to their immediate supervisor when it is safe to do so. #### 3.4 Incident Investigation

Incidents will be fully investigated to determine root cause(s) and any potential impacts to the business, the environment and the respective communities in the area that the incident occurred.

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# 3.5 Compliance Assurance

Chesapeake operations are subject to recurring audit including prompt corrective actions, risk assessment, and continuous improvement.
